and copays or coinsurance than
Preferred Provider Organizations
(PPOs).

With an HMO you must pick a primary care physician (PCP) who will provide most of your health care and coordinates care you need from other providers.





- Your PCP is affiliated with a medical group and makes referrals to specialists within the same medical group



Many covered services, including visits to a specialist, require a referral or prior authorization from your medical group.


Your medical group must give you prior authorization to see a provider or obtain services and supplies from providers outside the medical group's network.

- A mail-order pharmacy program through Postal Prescription Services, conveniently providing a three-month supply, as your benefit plan allows, for maintenance medications

- A robust formulary:
 - o Tier 1 most generic medications and low-cost preferred brands are covered at lowest cost share
 - Tier 2 preferred brand name and non-preferred generic medications are covered at second lowest cost share
 - Tier 3 non-preferred brand name drugs are covered at the third-tier cost share level. These
 generally have a preferred and often less costly therapeutic alternative at a lower tier
 - Tier 4 specialty drugs, self-administered drugs that require training or clinical monitoring, and bioengineered drugs are covered at the fourth-tier cost share level

Refill available prescriptions and request a written prescription

After effective date, members should:

 Refill prescriptions through MedImpact network pharmacy and consider mail order fulfillment through PPS


